



For each holiday, each employee in a benefits eligible position shall receive holiday credit equal to the number of hours regularly scheduled to work. "Holiday credit" means pay or credit for paid time off at a straight-time rate. Benefits eligible employees are compensated for time worked on a holiday at a rate of an additional 1½ hours of compensation for each hour worked. An FLSA nonexempt employee may, with the approval of the Appointing Authority, elect to accrue compensatory time in lieu of monetary payment.
